Use the IRS Online Portal

Once you register online and verify your identity, you'll be able to access your account. Here, you can see your payoff amount, your account balance, and payment history.

Give the IRS a Ring

If you'd rather talk to an IRS rep to get your balance, give them a call. We suggest calling earlier in the day to avoid longer wait times.



Mail the IRS a Form

While this option will take longer, you can always shoot the IRS a completed Form 4506-T to request your transcript. Penalties and interest will keep accruing while you're waiting for a response.
